





Differences between Old and New Google Sites

- ✓ Does not contain anymore File Cabinets
 - √ No file storage anymore in Google site.
 - ✓ File storage is exclusively in Gdrive
- √ No lists anymore
 - √ If you need a list, you must create a google speadsheet and embed it.
- ✓ No Site List
 - ✓ Sites are stored in Gdrives of each user
 - √ gam all users show filelist query "mimeType = 'application/vnd.google-apps.site'"

Site Migration : what is new?



- New Google sites are migrated to
 - Modern Sites
 - Microsoft Teams (the SharePoint site of a Microsoft Team)
- New Google sites are no longer migrated to Classic SharePoint Sites
- Pages are migrated to Modern SharePoint Pages
- Files are migrated to OneDrive and linked to the Site
 - If the file already exists in OneDrive, it will be used.

Differences between Google Site / SharePoint



Google: Horizontal and Vertical Menu

No vertical Menu in Modern SharePoint Sites

Google: Can link any calendar

SharePoint: can Link only to Microsoft team calendar

Google: Layout up to 4 columns

SharePoint: Layout up to 3 columns


NEW - SharePoint: Folder viewer for OneDrive Content.



Discovery



- Stored in every User's GDrives
- No consolidated list
- Need to search every drive
- gam all users show filelist query "mimeType = 'application/vnd.googleapps.site'"



File Migration



- Files are stored in Gdrive
- Gdrive FileId does not permit to determine owner
- But programmatic access to file requires to connect to owner's drive
- SOLUTION
 - Audit all Gdrives (requires File Migration License).
 - Generate list of all FileIds per user and store them.
 - No data or metadata stored.
 - GetOwner(FileId) retrieves the owner, then connects to its drive
 - If owner not found, file is not migrated
 - In classic site migration, there was an attempt to migrate with migration account defined in source connector (Binded to drive of migration account and tried to access file)
 - It could migrate the file if it had access to.

File Migration (Continue)



- If file exists at the target
 - Global settings to determine behavior
 - Use Target File
 - Overwrite Target File
- Migration to OneDrive
 - Requires a manual installation of a OneDrive Webpart Viewer in the tenant

Calendar Migration



- Calendar webpart lists only teams agenda
- Workaround
- No more calendar list in SharePoint
- Instead, create a list with 2 DateTime Columns
 - No recurrences, no user list, etc....
